TAKING DOWN THE GREENS

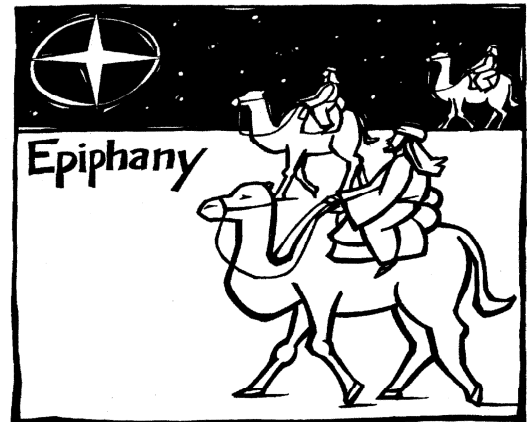
On Monday, January 4th @ 7:00 PM, all the greens will be taken down. It's a good time to volunteer your services.
