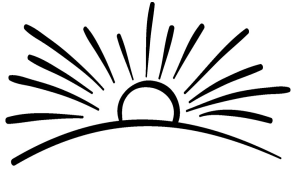

FEBRUARY SOCIAL CONCERN

(Formerly Tri City Homeless Coalition)

588 Brown Road

They have been active for 20 years.

Sixty-six people may live there for up to 3 months -- men, women & children.

Our concern is the Federal Emergency Shelter Grant Program has denied a grant for \$267,195⁰⁰ for the 2 years in financial support to the 66 bed facility.

Without this funding, Abode may have to close the shelter from 10 AM to 6 PM , which would make it useless to residents who work night jobs and sleep during the day.

Another result may be to eliminate eight full-time positions and close four homes for families transitioning from homelessness in Hayward.

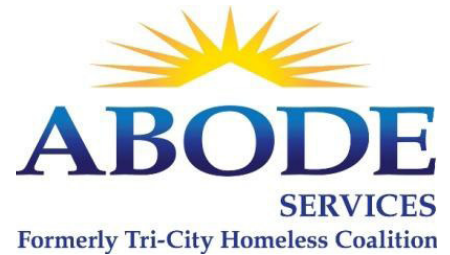
